Located in downtown Monroe, the <u>Monroe County Historical Museum</u> holds a significant Custer collection as well as many local sites of interest to Custer historians.

A major component of the Library's Custer collection was obtained by Monroe's resident Custer historian, the late Dr. Lawrence A. Frost, in 1977; and continues to grow steadily through additional acquisitions. The collection houses numerous books on the Civil War, Indians, and the Custer story; but also maintains a wide variety of maps, photographs, video tapes, slides, sound recordings, paintings, and an extensive subject/vertical file.
