William E. Fielding was an established Bedford Township resident and held many offices throughout the township and Monroe County. He served in WWI, married Helen Couture (whose parents were William Albert and Ivadell (Pomeroy) Couture, and was an insurance agent at Fielding & Krueger Insurance Agency. He was also the "Last Man" in the Last Man's WWI Club. William is buried in Blouch Cemetery.
